Dr. Stacey Hunter, Kaydee Owen, Dr. Richard Watkins, Dr. Mike Beverley, & Professor Carl Hughes, Bangor University, Wales, UK, announce a one year RCT study involving 63 Welsh schools (approx. 630 children) beginning in 2017 in which schools will be trained in Precision Teaching and SAFMEDS to improve basic numeracy skills, including behavioral analysis and the Standard Celeration Chart. All schools get the intervention and training but only half will be provided with ongoing implementation support and help with data analysis. Control schools will be trained in the use but will not receive implementation support.

Two years later, Malcolm D. Neely expanded the list for his acceptance speech of the Ogden R. Lindsley Life-Time Achievement Award in Chicago at the 25th *Annual International Precision Teaching Conference*, December 2012. This 2012 expansion listed 28 PT Schools in 13 U.S. states and 2 other countries. The Standard Celeration Community encouraged Neely to continue developing the list into a directory of “Organizations Using the Standard Celeration Chart (SCC)”. The label, *schools*, was limiting and some users consider their facilities as other types of learning places or just organizations who use the SCC in analyses, decision-making, and accountability.

The list of *Organizations* does not show the number of SCC users or what they measure. Many teachers in classrooms use the SCC, but the academic institution does not yet identify itself with the movement. Parents and individuals use the chart with no affiliation. Some users track their business pinpoints, some study life and some study worldly issues using the SCC. A more revealing list would be one listing individuals using the SCC with descriptions as to *what* they are counting and tracking.
