

Accessibility & Inclusion FAQs (Available Year-Round)

Accessibility and inclusion are central to our mission at the SCS. These FAQs remain available year round on our website so members and conference attendees can easily find information about the supports and resources that help make our events welcoming and accessible. We update this page as new conference venues are confirmed so attendees have the most accurate and location-specific accessibility information. Our goal is to ensure that everyone has what they need to participate fully and comfortably. If you have an accessibility need that is not addressed here, we invite you to reach out so we can continue to improve our process.

Financial & Registration Support

Q: Do you offer conference scholarships?

A: Yes. We offer three types of scholarships for conference attendees: Diversity, Student, and Rising Professional. Scholarship applications can be accessed on the conference website at

For the 2026 Annual Conference, applications are open April 1 – June 26. If you are viewing this after the deadline, please contact the Executive Director at executive@celeration.org to inquire about any remaining opportunities.

In some years, additional scholarships have become available when a selected recipient is unable to attend. If this occurs, we review the existing applicant pool and reach out to eligible individuals who have expressed continued interest.

Q: Is accessible registration available?

A: Yes. If you prefer to register and pick up your name badge at a quieter or less busy time, indicate this during online registration or email programs@celeration.org.

Q: Who do I contact for registration issues?

A: Email programs@celeration.org or visit the registration desk during the conference.

Facilities & On-Site Accessibility

Q: Are all-gender restrooms available?

A: Yes. We confirm availability when booking the venue and share locations at the opening session, between sessions, in the app, and at the registration desk.

Q: Is there a “mommy and me” room for nursing and pumping?

A: Yes. Locations are shared at the registration desk at the conference and will be in the conference app. A refrigerator is available for storing breast milk.

Q: Is there a quiet room?

A: Yes. Details are provided in the app and at the registration desk at the conference.

Q: How do I share dietary restrictions?

A: Indicate them during online registration or email programs@celeration.org. During the conference, visit the registration desk.

Q: What meals are provided?

A: Buffet lunch on Friday and Saturday and afternoon snacks both days. Assistance with navigating the buffet line is available upon request.

Q: Is accessible transportation available from the airport?

A: Yes. Please see below for information. If you need further assistance email programs@celeration.org.

Airline Assistance: [RNO Airport](#) offers wheelchair services to transport passengers from the gate to the ground transportation area.

Accessible Taxis: [Reno Sparks Cab](#) provides ADA-compliant vehicles with ramps and assistance for passengers with mobility challenges

Rideshares: Both Uber and Lyft operate at RNO and may provide accessible vehicle options, though it is best to request in advance.

Q: Are printed materials available?

A: Yes. Printed copies of key materials are available at registration.

Q: What floors are registration and the meeting rooms located?

A: For the 2026 Annual Conference, the Whitney Peak in Reno, Nevada is our venue. We have secured the entire third floor of the hotel. Registration and all events will take place on the third floor of the hotel.

Q: How are pronouns supported?
